P 51. INNOVATION – K.E.M. KANGAROO BAG FOR KANGAROO MOTHER

Background: Kangaroo Mother Care(KMC) ensures temperature maintenance , promotes successful breast feeding, reduces nosocomial sepsis, increases mother infant bonding and maternal satisfaction. Mother serves as a natural and the best incubator. KMC is simple and ideal for developing countries with limited health resources and does not require sophisticated instruments. The innovation: the kangaroo bag design in our Institute is made of soft flannel cloth and is tailored to hold the baby doubly secured in between the mother's breasts. Method: A randomized control trial was conducted to study the effect of KMC Vs Conventional method of care (CMC) in 100 LBWI < 1800 g between June 2001 to December 2001.

Result: The incidence of hypothermia, serious illnesses and new episodes of sepsis were significantly (p<0.05) lower in KMC group (6%, 2% and 8 % respectively). All mothers in KMC group were confident of caring for their baby in KMC and felt that the bag was absolutely safe with no risk of baby falling or slipping. **Conclusion**: KMC is a basic right of the newborn and should be considered an integral part of the management of the LBW infants. K.E.M kangaroo bag is a safe, cost effective and comfortable way of aiding mothers to provide Kangaroo Mother Care. **Keywords:** KMC bag, safety, illnesses
